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NOTES FOR THE TEAM MANAGERS -TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Entries will close on **Friday 2 November 2012** and all entries must be accompanied by the entry fee or they will not be accepted. Camping and stabling fees should also be included, if applicable. Nomination fees are non-refundable (unless in the event of a postponement or cancellation) and must accompany entry form.

- **Team Managers** must ensure that each rider's equipment is **SAFE** and are responsible for their team. Smooth soled boots and either ASNZ3838, ASTM F1163 and EN1384 helmets must be worn. Random checks will be performed throughout the day. Any queries to be directed to stewards.
- **Team Managers** are required to carry out a gear check on all of their competitors and horses according to Pony Club Association guidelines. Gear must be checked prior to the 8.30 am start and if a rider replaces or changes gear prior to commencing the sporting events.
- **Team Managers** are responsible for reporting in and collecting gear check stickers and registering attendance.
- All children 8 years + participating must be competent riders.
- **HORSE FREE parking areas** will be available.
- Each School's Team Manager has a duty of care for their students and is responsible for the supervision and behaviour of students. Should there be any queries or problems during the day, the **Team Manager** is the person designated to negotiate on behalf of the rider/school.
- **Team Manager must be in attendance on the day for the duration of the day.**
- Any Competitor not complying with **Pony Club Rules** will be stood down.
- Competitors are required to walk at all times on the grounds except in warm up area and when competing. "Hooping" around on horses between events is not allowed.
- Please ensure your competitors are on time and in the correct location for their events.
- **Scratching** – To be notified to the Office as early as possible.
- **NO DOGS ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS.**
- In addition to the Team Entry Form, each rider is required to complete a Rider Information Form, a Disclaimer and PSSA Medical Information Form. **Entries for riders without completed and signed forms will not be accepted.**
- One horse, one rider on the day. No spectators are permitted on competitor horse.
- Pony Club Rules apply. Any competitor not complying with Pony Club Rules will be stood down.
- To ride at this event the rider does not have to be a pony club member.
- **Age will be "Age competitor turns this year" as at 31 December 2012.**

- Schools may enter any number of students.
- **Workers** – the School **SHOULD** provide the name of **two workers**, other than team manager to assist on the day. ***Please report to the Office at the start of the day to collect registration tags.***
- **Team Managers are responsible for gear checks of their team.** Any queries should be directed to stewards. All gear must be in accordance with Pony Club Standards.
- School ties, beige jodhpurs and jumpers to be worn – NO COATS. School sports shirts may be worn in sporting events.
- Point Score: 1st = 5 points, 2nd = 4 points, 3rd = 3 points, 4th = 2 points, 5th = 1 points
- Judging of Champion and Reserve Rider. - Only first placings in the applicable rider classes shall be eligible for the judging of Champion. The remaining firsts and the second place getter to the Champion shall be eligible for the judging of Reserve Champion.
- The Committee reserves the right to alter or delete any event. In all cases the decision of the Committee will be final.
- **Disputes** must be lodged with the Secretary within 10 minutes of the completion of the event. A fee of \$70 must be lodged simultaneously and will be returned if dispute is upheld.
- **Team Managers** are responsible for the competitors on the day. All enquiries should be made through the Team Manager and not directed to the Office Workers.
- To be eligible for championship points there must be more than two entries in each age group.
- Judge's decision is FINAL.
- Cancellations due to wet weather will be announced over Radios 2TM and 100.3 Armidale after the 6.00 am news on the day or ring 0427 462473 for a recorded message.
- The Committee reserves the right to alter or delete any event.
- Any competitor who wishes to participate in Woolbrook Public School Horse Sports Day must complete the attached Disclaimer Statement and PSSA Medical Information Sheet and returned with the Nomination Form. Non competitors ie parents, spectators or persons assisting students at the event are not covered by our insurance. Only the nominated rider/competitor can ride horse/s at any time during the competition. Woolbrook Public School P & C Association takes no responsibility for persons (other than Woolbrook Public School P & C Association Organising Committee members) on the grounds areas outside the period 7.00 am Friday, 9 November to 5.00 pm on Friday, 9 November 2012.
