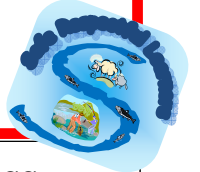

The P&C have purchased navy, soft broad brim hats and they are available at school for \$10.

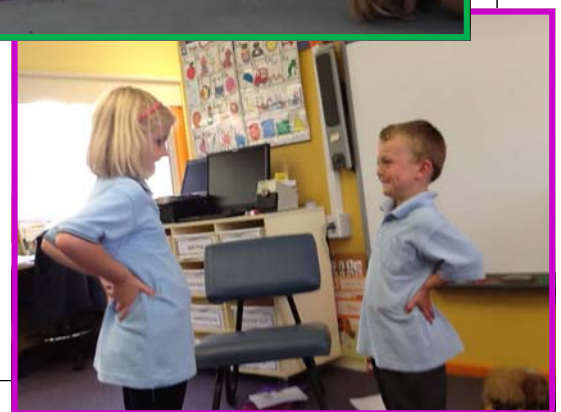


Small Schools Cross Country
