P&C Reminder - that we are collecting hamper items at school for the Christmas Hamper that will be raffled on *Presentation Night*.

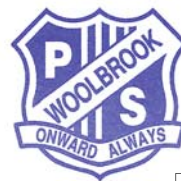

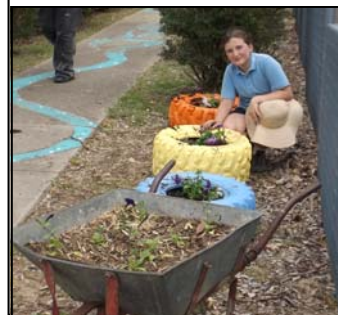
Weeks 3 & 4 Term 4 Friday 4 November 2016
