Notification: Country Rail will commence to begin improvements to the train line from 28 June until the end of July. There may be heavy machinery noise and traffic delays at crossings.

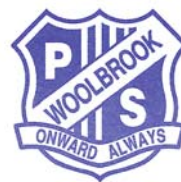
