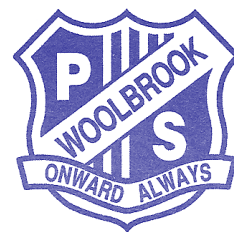

Walcha Council Meeting

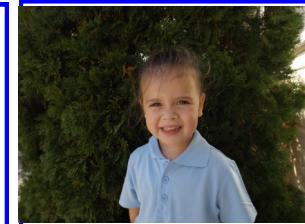

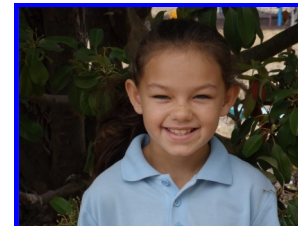
