Safe Respectful Learners

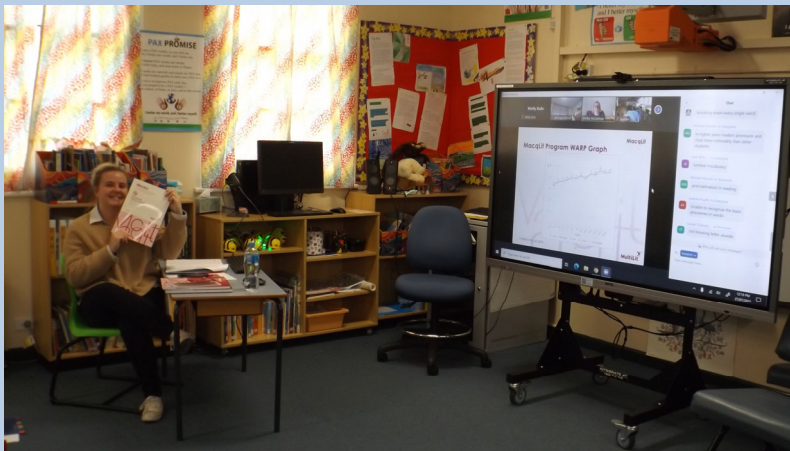
PSSA Athletics
